ORDER RESCINDED

On April 04, 2020 at 12:00 noon, and subsequently amended, April 09, 2020, Monongalia County Health Department ordered certain limitations of spirits and hard liquor sales for protection of citizens and visitors of West Virginia and Monongalia County. That order is now rescinded which removes limitations on quantities able to be purchased and removes limiting of sales to only those individuals with West Virginia, student, residential, or military identification.

Because Covid-19 remains an ongoing infectious disease that is highly communicable and has significant health concerns for those infected, including serious illness, hospitalization, or even death; Monongalia County Health Department encourages all businesses to continue observing the following precautions:

Maintaining a distance of six feet between customers and staff at all times, using floor markings or tape at cash registers or other places where individuals congregate;

Limiting individuals to no more than 2 people per 1000 square feet excluding staff during store hours or when open for business;

Providing adequate hand-washing stations especially at places where paper or other items are exchanged between staff and clientele;

Frequently wipe down surfaces with 10 % bleach solution or similar CDC approved cleaner anywhere any individual's hands may reach including telephones, keyboards, light switches, doorknobs, handrails, etc.;

Wearing a mask or face covering while in public, staying home when ill and any other common-sense measures that will limit spread of communicable diseases.

This notification becomes effective upon signing and we appreciate everyone's assistance in helping to keep Monongalia County's rate of Covid-19 infection low.
