**A Mountain Line employee has tested positive for COVID-19.**

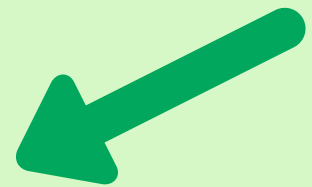
**All contacts of this employee have been identified and Monongalia County Health Department is working with Mountain Line to take the necessary steps to test, isolate and trace potential additional contacts.**

**Mountain Line has taken aggressive steps to protect the safety of its transit operations since the beginning of the pandemic. All buses are fumigated with DSV (disinfectant, sanitizer, virucide) on a daily basis, plus several other measures to ensure the safety of employees and passengers are utilized.**

**Mountain Line has set up a system for riders to call in and register their trip in order to provide MCHD with tracking information in the case of a positive test.**

**From now on, MOUNTAIN LINE PASSENGERS WILL:**

- be asked to socially distance on the bus;**
- you are requested to wear a face covering;**
- call 304-296-3680 to register your trip.**
